

Bibliography of Field Experimental Studies of Race-Ethnic Discrimination in Hiring Analyzed in “Comparative Perspectives on Racial Discrimination in Hiring: The Rise of Field Experiments”

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Notes:

1. In general, study documents contain one field experimental study each.
2. In some cases, single study documents included multiple distinct studies (e.g. both a resume audit and an in-person audit). These are noted by square brackets after the study indicating the number of studies coded from the document (if no square bracket then only one study was coded from the document). In a few cases (also noted) more than one document was used to code a study.
3. Study documents are listed by country, with the total number of studies after the country name.
