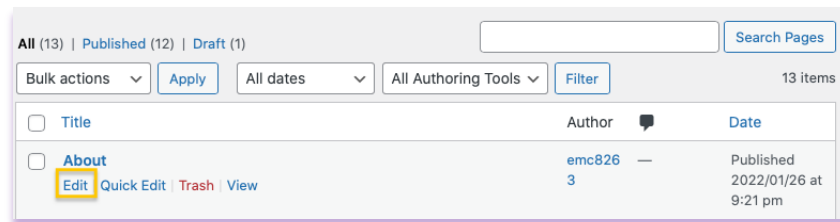
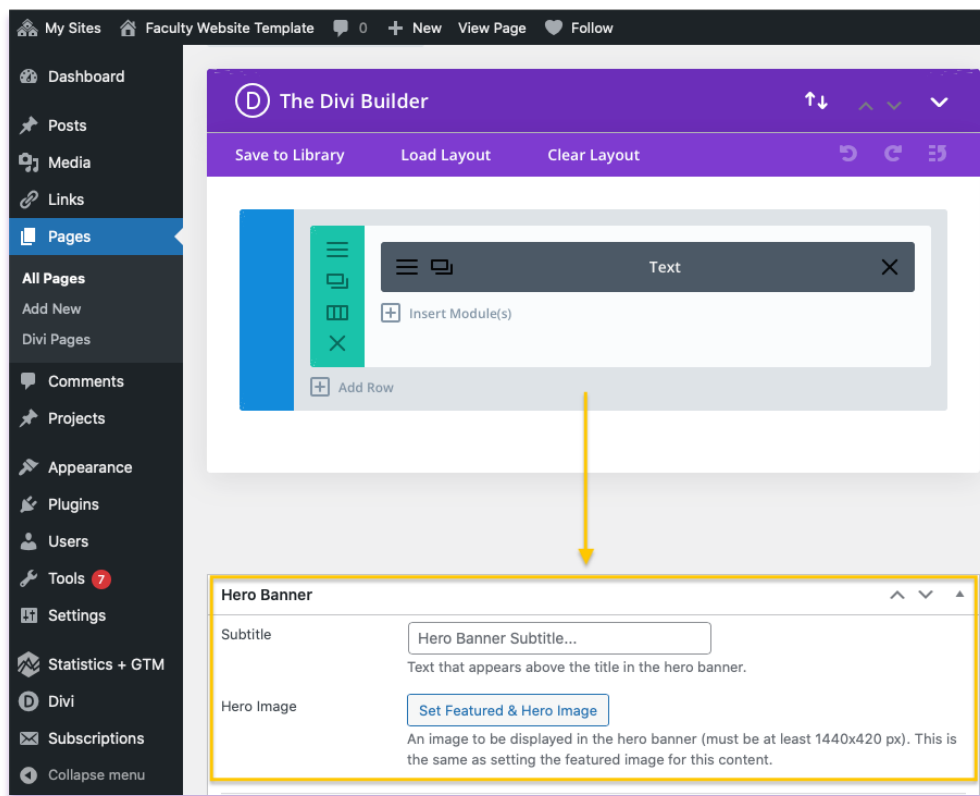


Adding Top/Featured Images to Pages

To add a top/featured image to one of your pages, you will need to select “**Edit**” for the page you want to insert a top/featured image on.



1. Once you are on the edit screen, scroll down below the “**Divi Builder**”, and you will find the “**Hero Banner**” section.



2. Then, simply hit the “**Set Featured & Hero Image**” button to access the “**Featured image**” upload window. Please make sure your header image is 1440 x 420 px before inserting it.

Subtitle
Text that appears above the title in the hero banner.

Hero Image
An image to be displayed in the hero banner (must be at least 1440x420 px). This is the same as setting the featured image for this content.

3. Now drag and drop the selected image into the selection area or add it from your media library by clicking the **“Select Files”** button.
4. Then click the blue button that says **“Set Featured Image”** marked in the image below. Clicking this will take you back to the page you were on.

Remember: Please make sure that your header image is 1440 x 420 px before inserting it.
